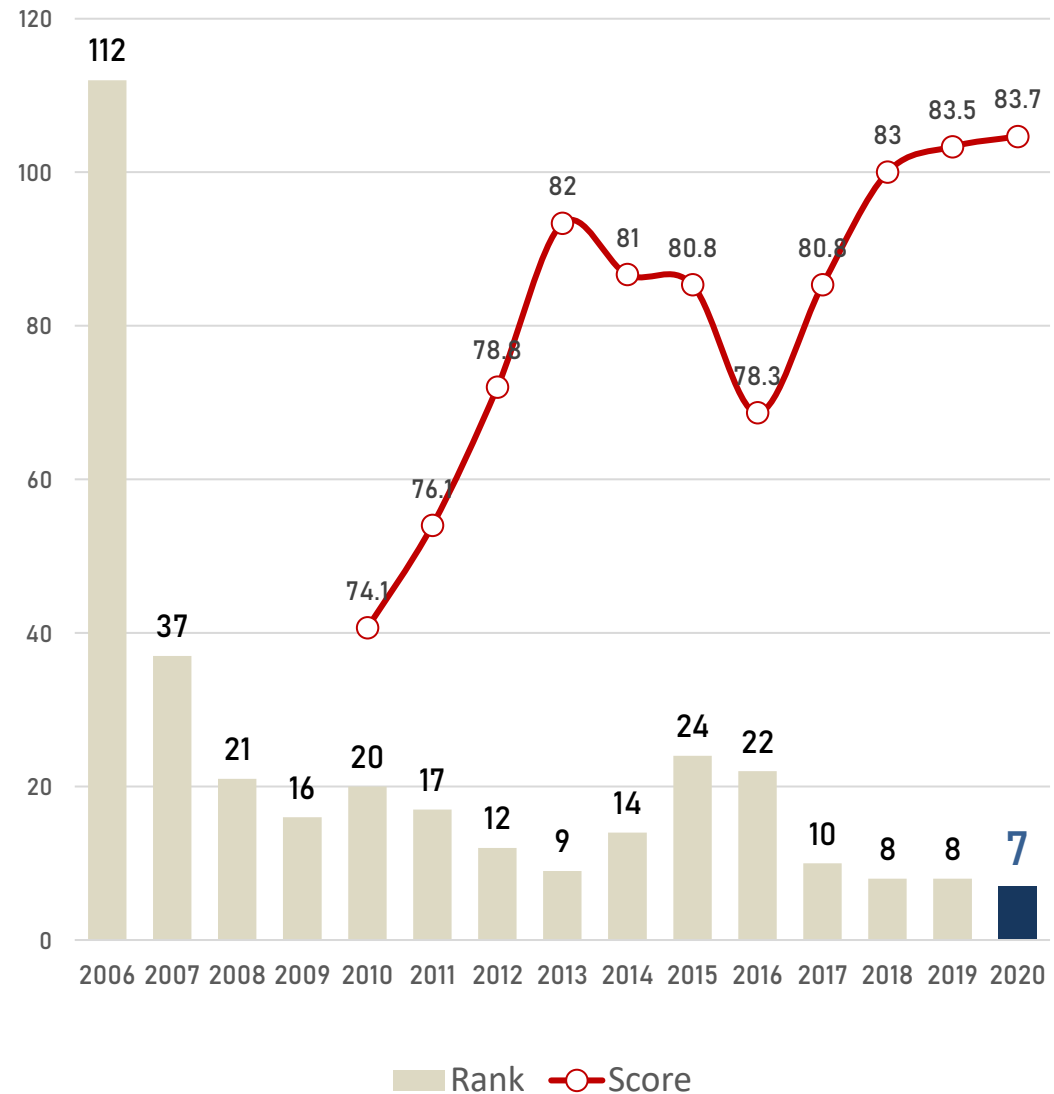

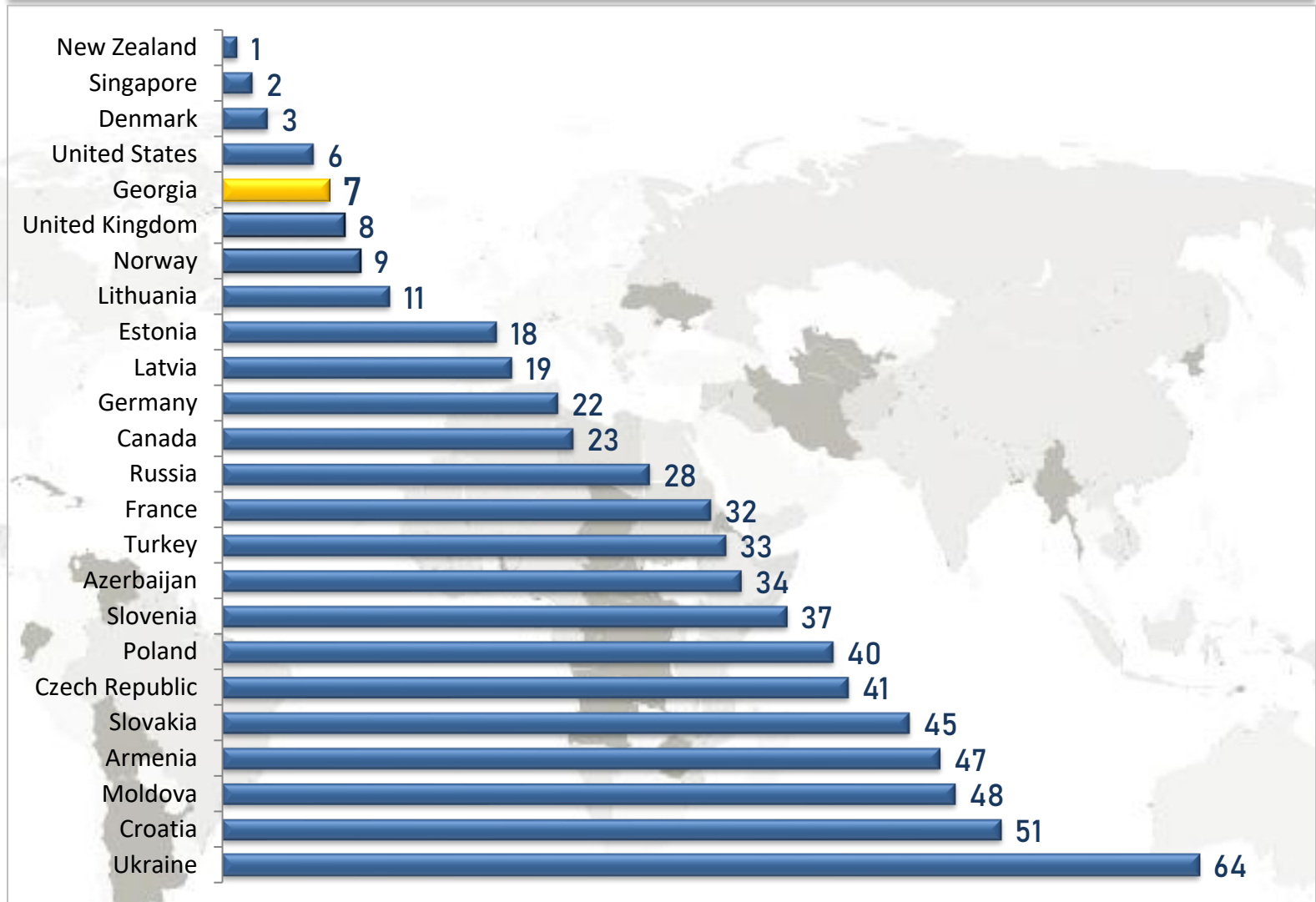

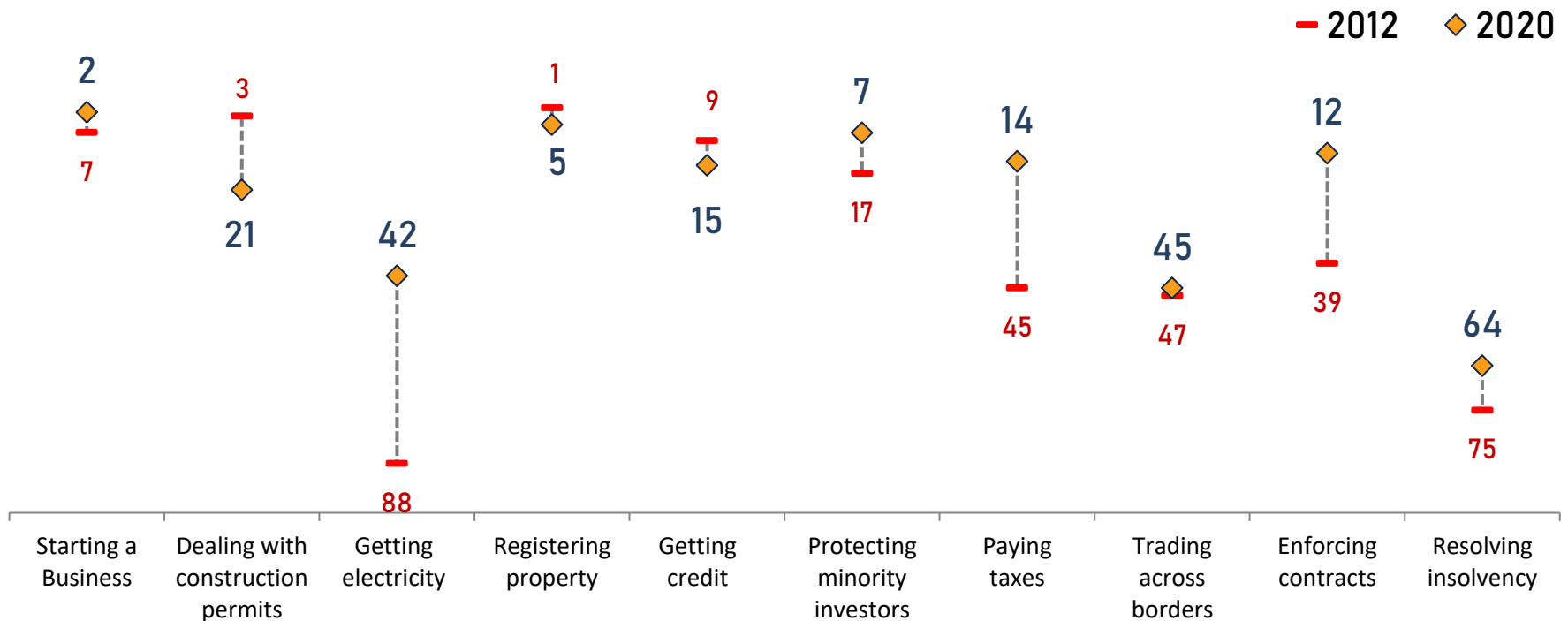

World Bank “Business-Ready”

In the World Bank's **Business Ready (B-READY) 2025** **Georgia** is in the **top four** among 50 countries, along with Korea, Singapore and Estonia

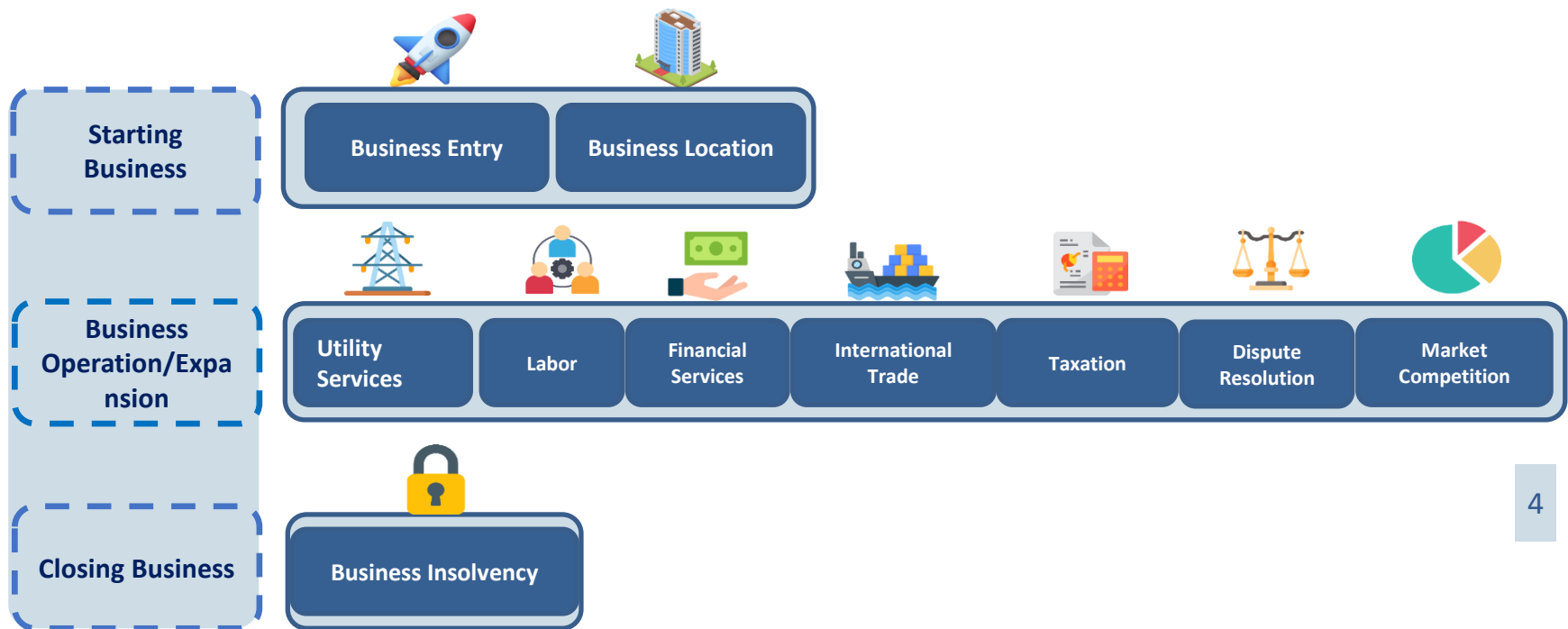
In the World Bank's **Business Ready (B-READY) 2025** Georgia is in the **top four** among 101 countries, along with Korea, Singapore and Estonia.

Georgia is among World's **top 10 countries** in 6 out of 10 indicators. In particular, Georgia is on **2nd position** – in “Dispute Resolution”, **4th position** – in “Business Location”, **7th position** – in “Labor”, **8th position** – in “Business Entry” and **9th position** – in “Financial Services” and “Taxation” indicators.

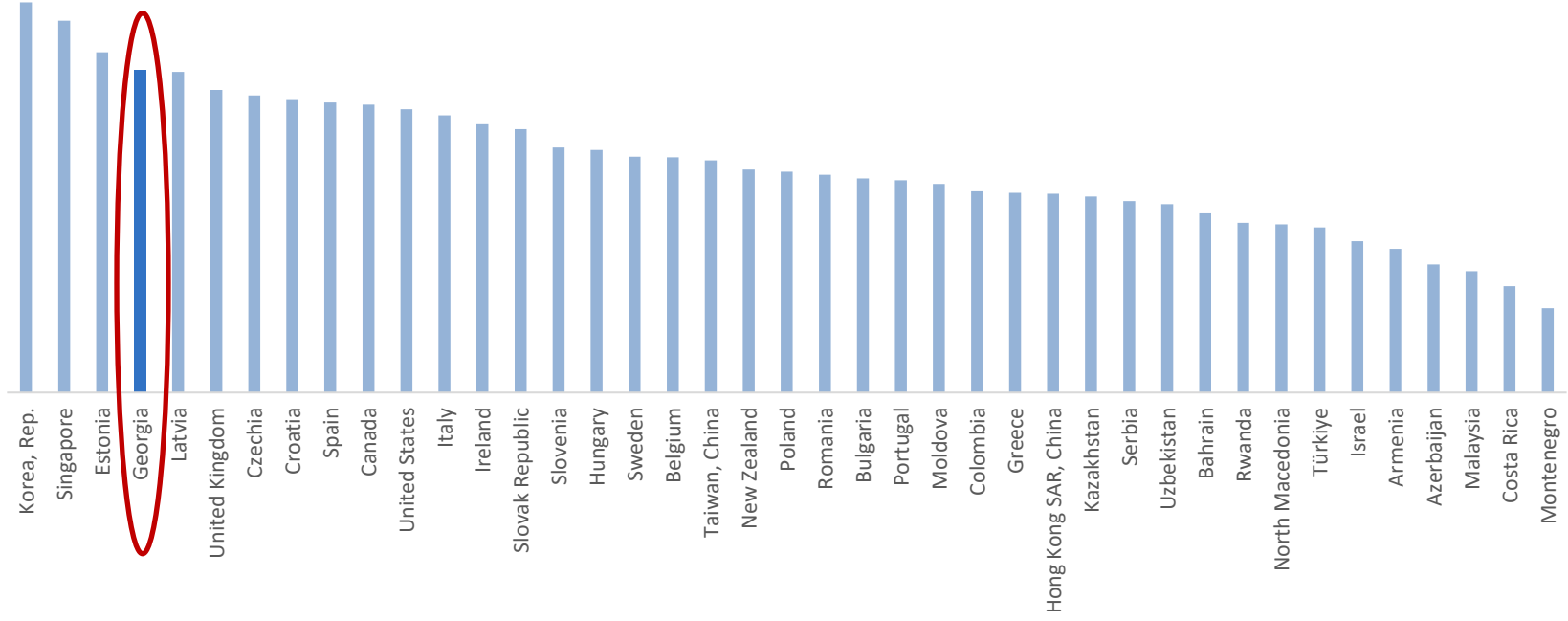
The purpose of the B-READY ranking is to **quantitatively and qualitatively** evaluate the business environment for the development of the private sector. B-Ready ranking has replaced the World Bank's Doing Business rating, where Georgia was **at the 7th position**.

Indicators

Indicators of the ranking “B-READY” combine all three stages of a company's life cycle: **starting business, business operation/expansion and closing business**, which include 10 main indicators.

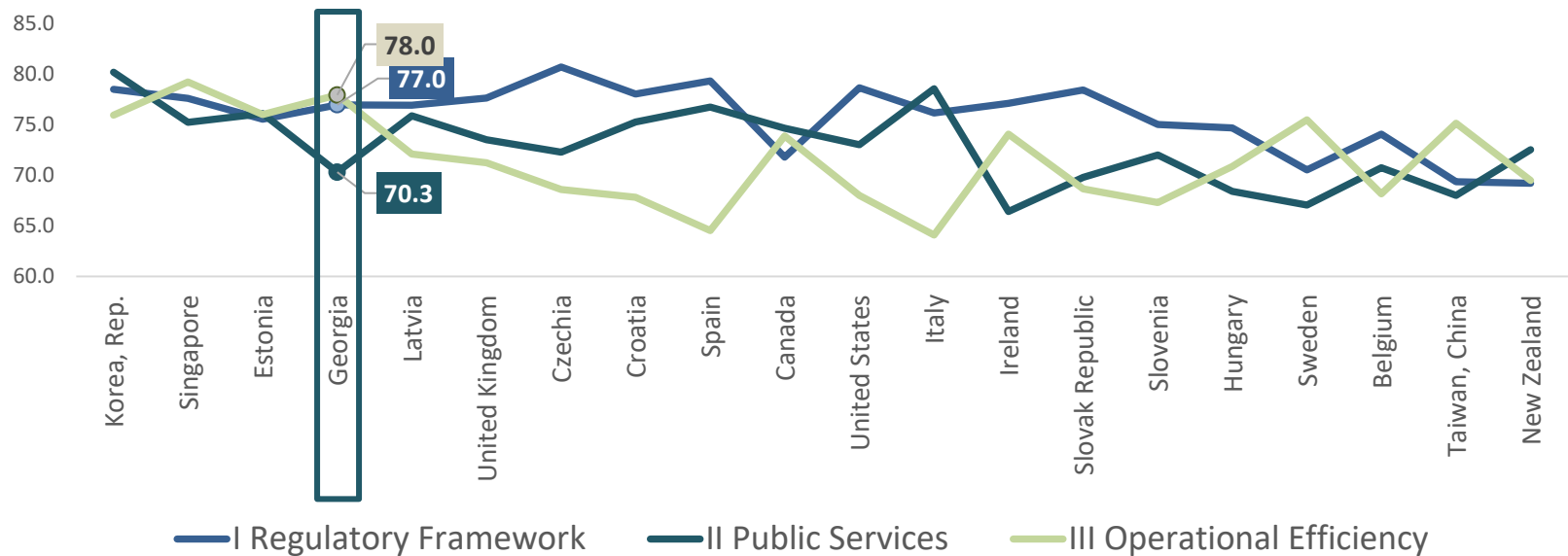


Georgia's Ranking Globally

In the ranking, each indicator is evaluated in **3 main directions** - "Regulatory Framework", "Public Services" and "Operational Efficiency".



Georgia ranks **2nd** position in the world ranking in "**Operational Efficiency**", in terms of "**Regulatory Framework**" the country is on **15th** position, and on the **19th** position in regarding the "**Public Services**" pillar.

■ „Regulatory Framework“ ■ „Public Services“ ■ „Operational Efficiency“



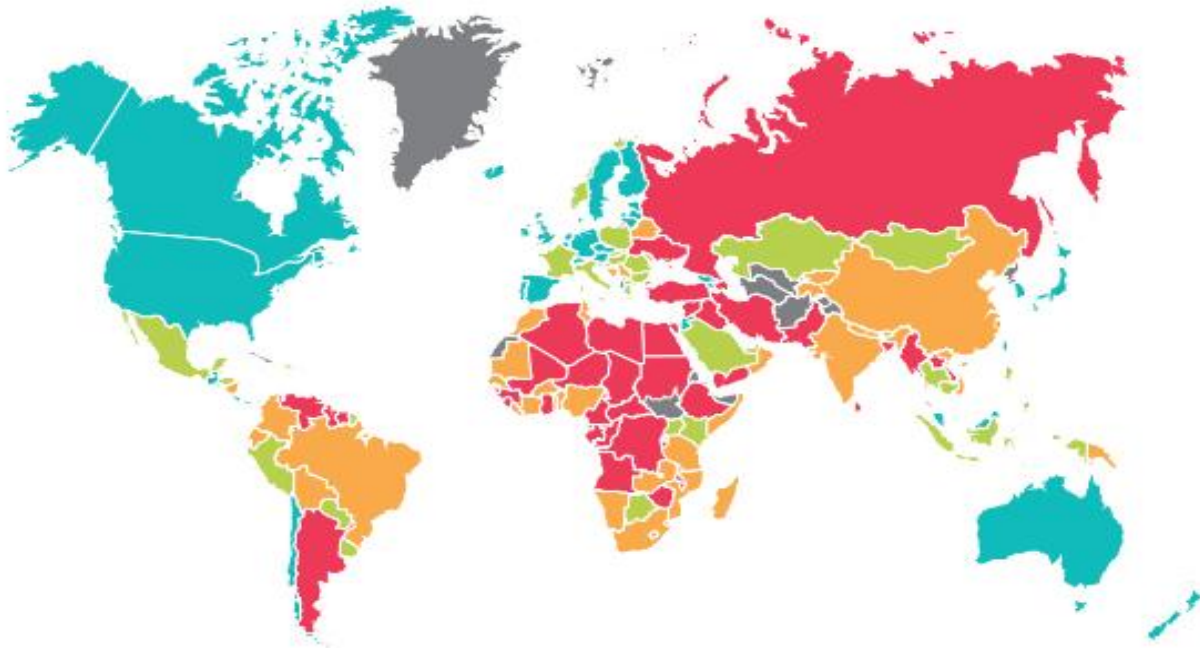

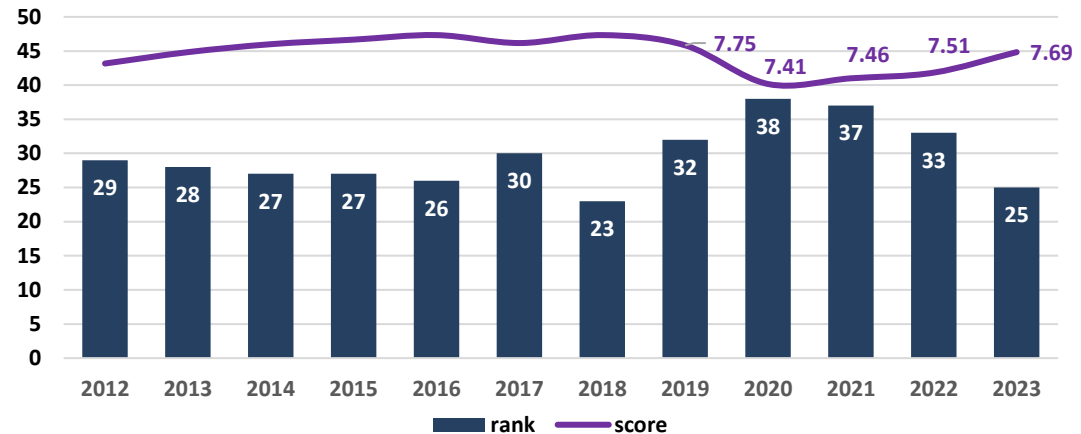

According to the “Economic freedom of the world” 2025 report, Georgia ranks 25th position among 165 countries worldwide with a score of 7.69.

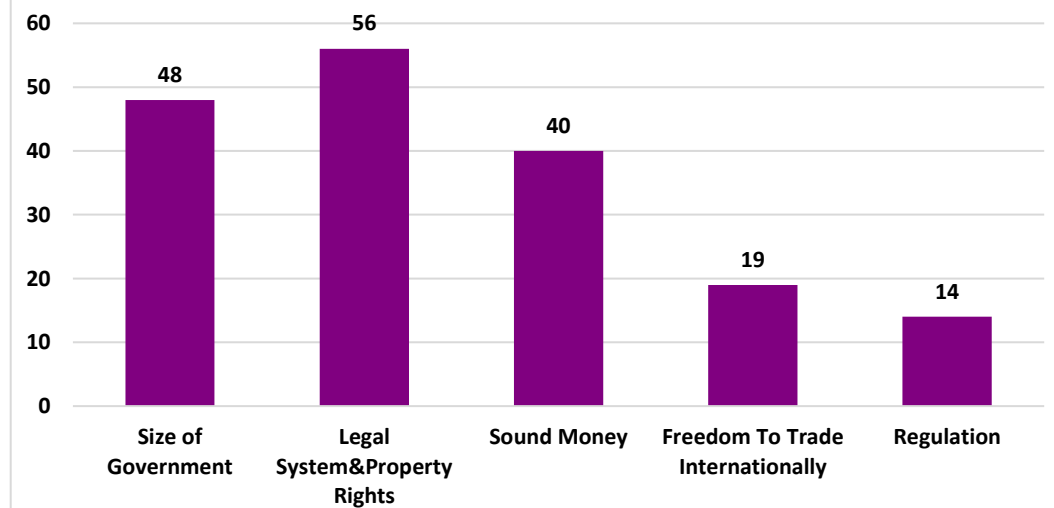
Georgia is evaluated in the rating with 5 indicators and 25 components

- Size of Government – 48th position with a score of 7.35
- Legal System & Property Rights – 56th position with a score of 5.82
- Sound Money – 40th position with a score of 8.90
- Freedom to Trade Internationally – 19th position with a score of 8.77
- Regulation – 14th position with a score of 7.62

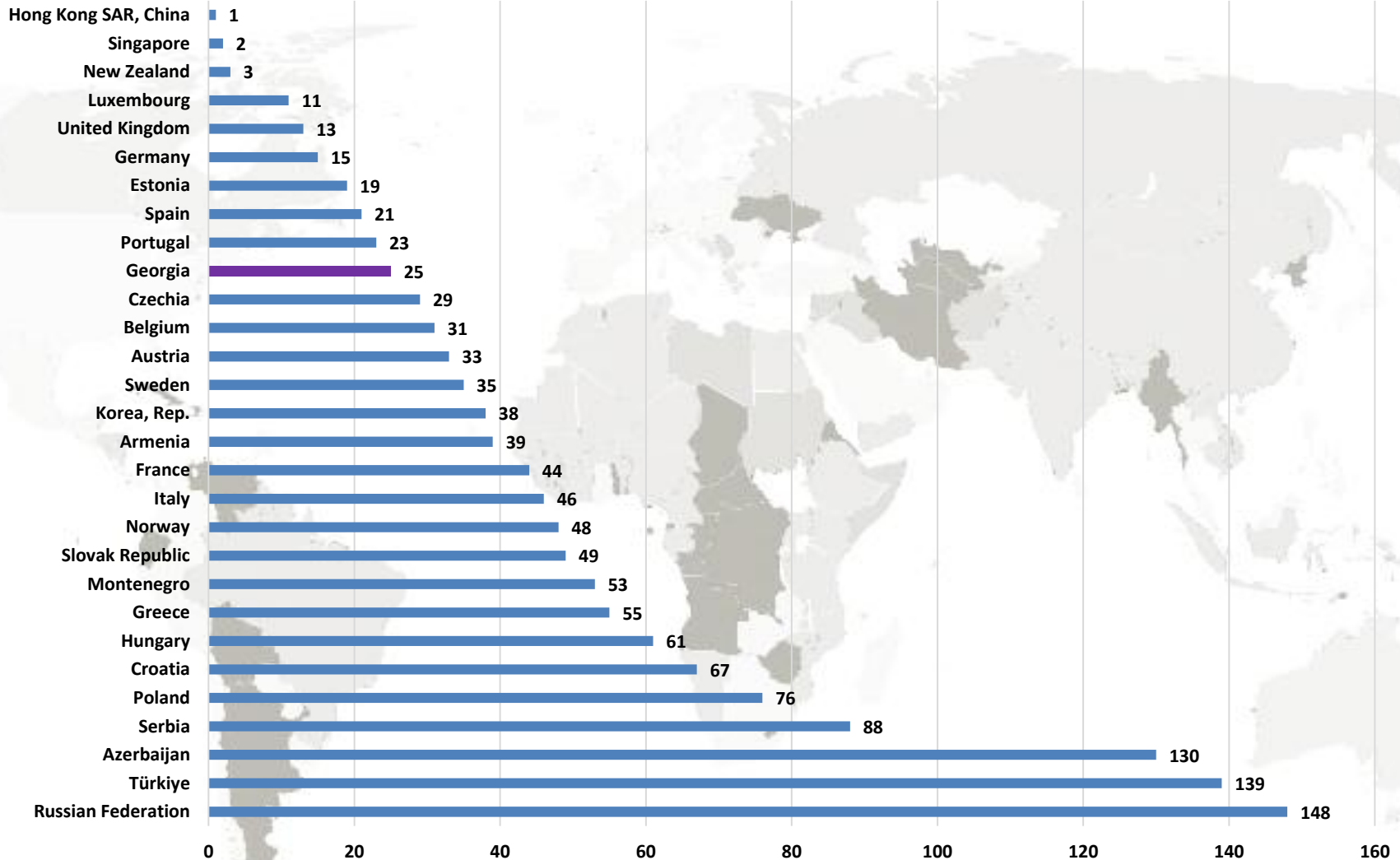


Georgia’s Position by the Indicators



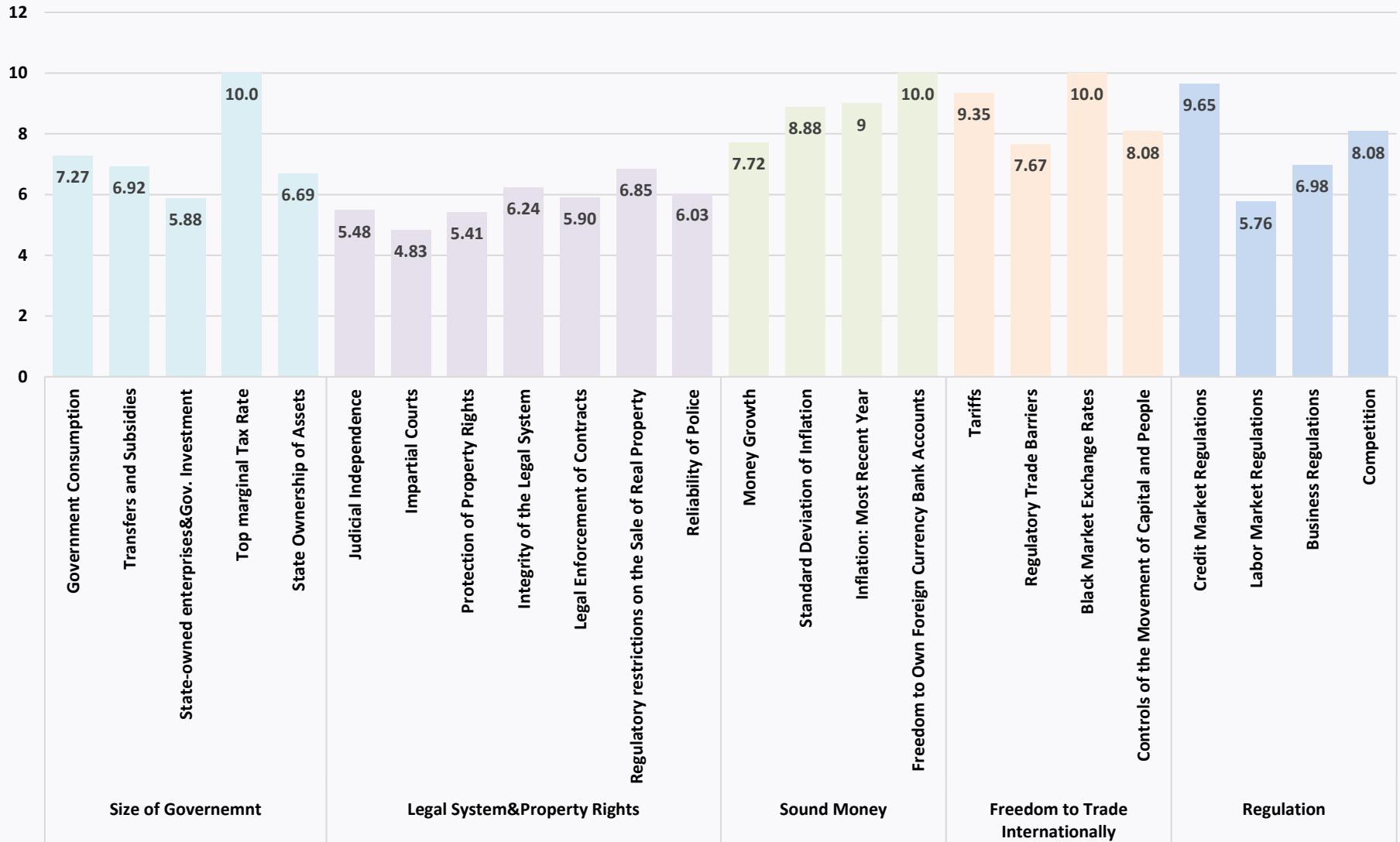

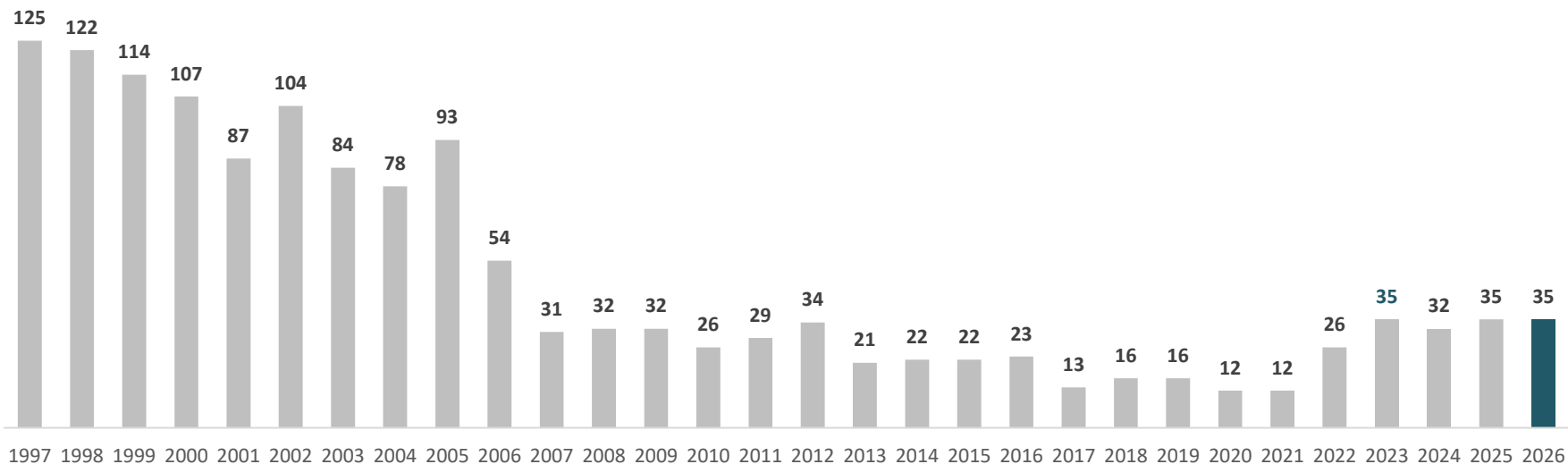

ECONOMIC FREEDOM SCORE COMPARISON

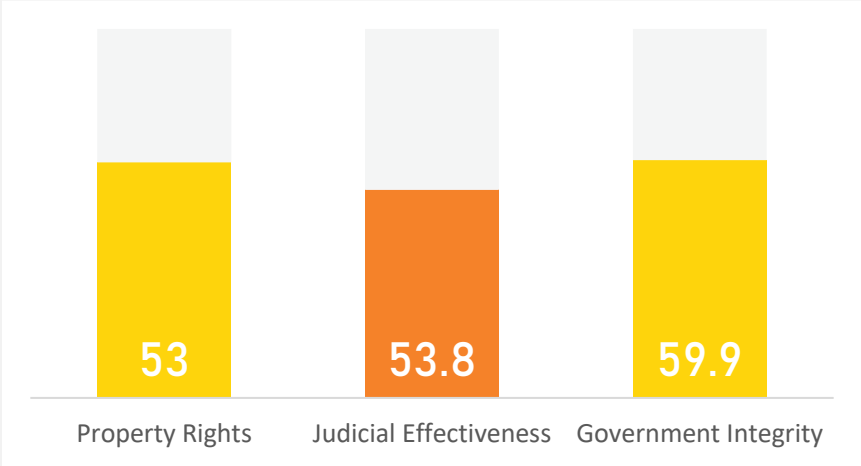

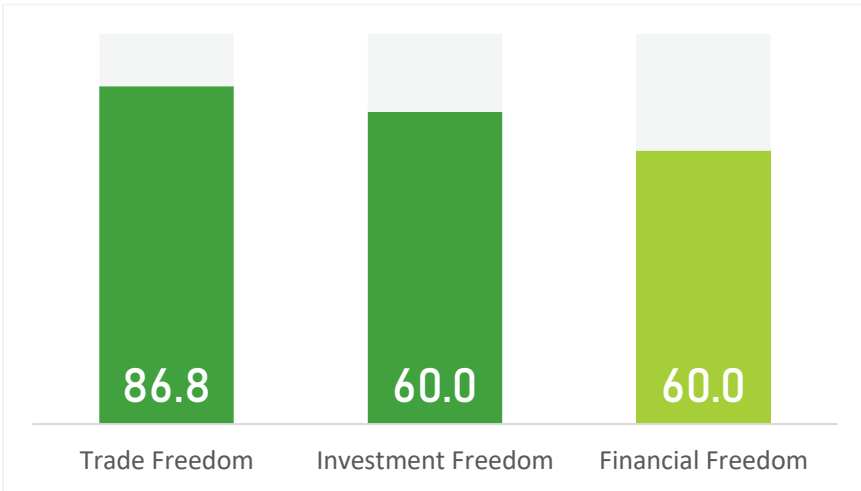

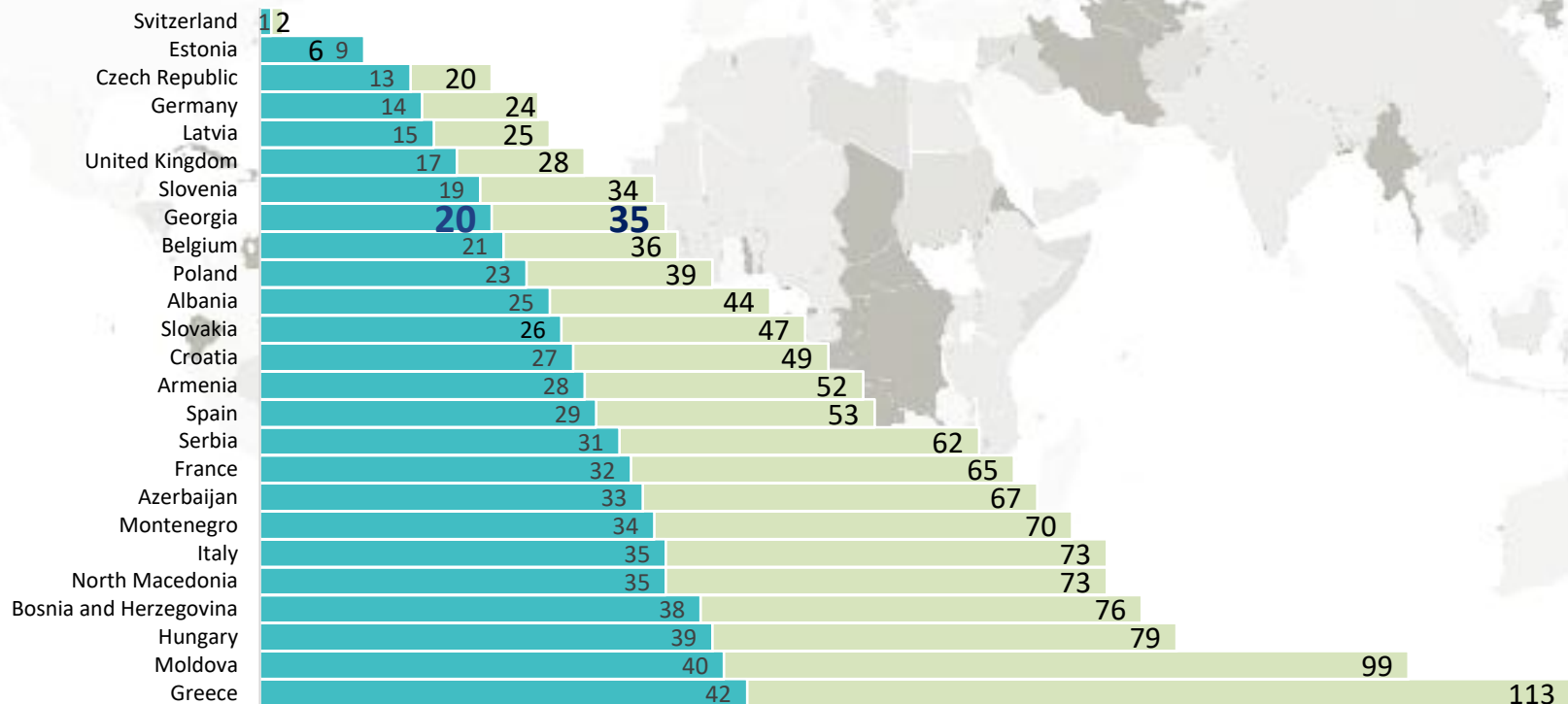

SME Policy Index 2024

- The SME Policy Index – Assessing the Implementation of the Small Business Act for Europe is a unique benchmarking tool to assess and monitor progress in the design and implementation of SME policies towards EU and international best practices.
- According to the [study](#) by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) „**SME Policy Index - 2024**“ Georgia achieved unprecedented success:
- Georgia maintains a leading position and gained the highest scores in 11 out of 12 dimensions among the Eastern Partnership countries in the OECD ranking “SME Policy Index 2024”.
- SME Policy Index“ evaluates Eastern Partnership (EaP) Countries in 12 dimensions within 5 pillars (Maximum 5 point).

SME Policy Index - Implementation progress

Responsive Government

- Adoption of the SME Development Strategy for the period 2021-2025.
- Application of the Law of Georgia on Mediation aiming to support alternative means of dispute resolution.
- Adoption of the Law on Rehabilitation and Collective Satisfaction of Creditors, providing a new framework for insolvency.
- Establishment of the Digital Governance Agency.

Entrepreneurial Human Capital

- Development of a methodology for the organizational assessment of vocational schools.
- Creation of the Skills Agency.
- Adoption of the SME Strategy for 2021-2025 with a new priority direction dedicated to women's entrepreneurship.
- Increase in online trainings for SMEs.

Access to Finance

- Publication of a Sustainable Finance taxonomy and related classification.
- Introduction of a requirement on commercial banks to report monthly on green loans.
- Integration of ESG issues into the Corporate Governance Code for issues of Public Securities.
- Relaunch and expansion of the national credit guarantee scheme due to the pandemic.
- Adoption of the Law on Micro banks.
- Adoption of a new National Strategy for Financial Education recognizing SMEs as a target group.
- Launch of the financial education website Fin Edu.

SME Policy Index - Implementation progress

Access to Markets

- Promotion of export growth and internationalization of SMEs.
- Enterprise Georgia's Export Assistance Program to co-finance technical assistance to exporting businesses.
- Establishment of an independent Market Surveillance Agency.
- Intensification of the approximation of national legislation with the EU acquis: GEOSTM CEN and CENELEC Affiliate status.
- Promoting the participation of small and medium-sized enterprise in public procurement.

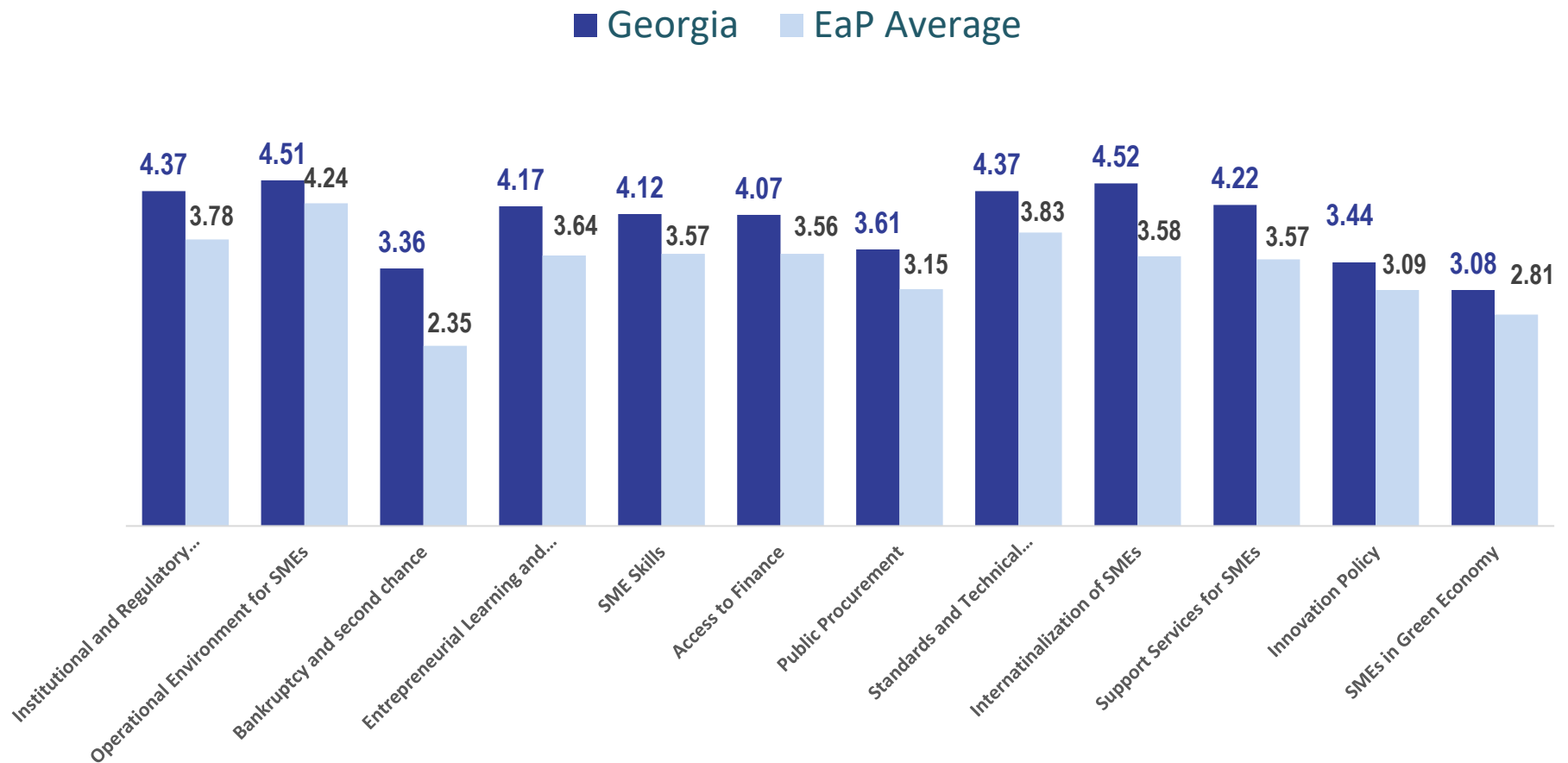

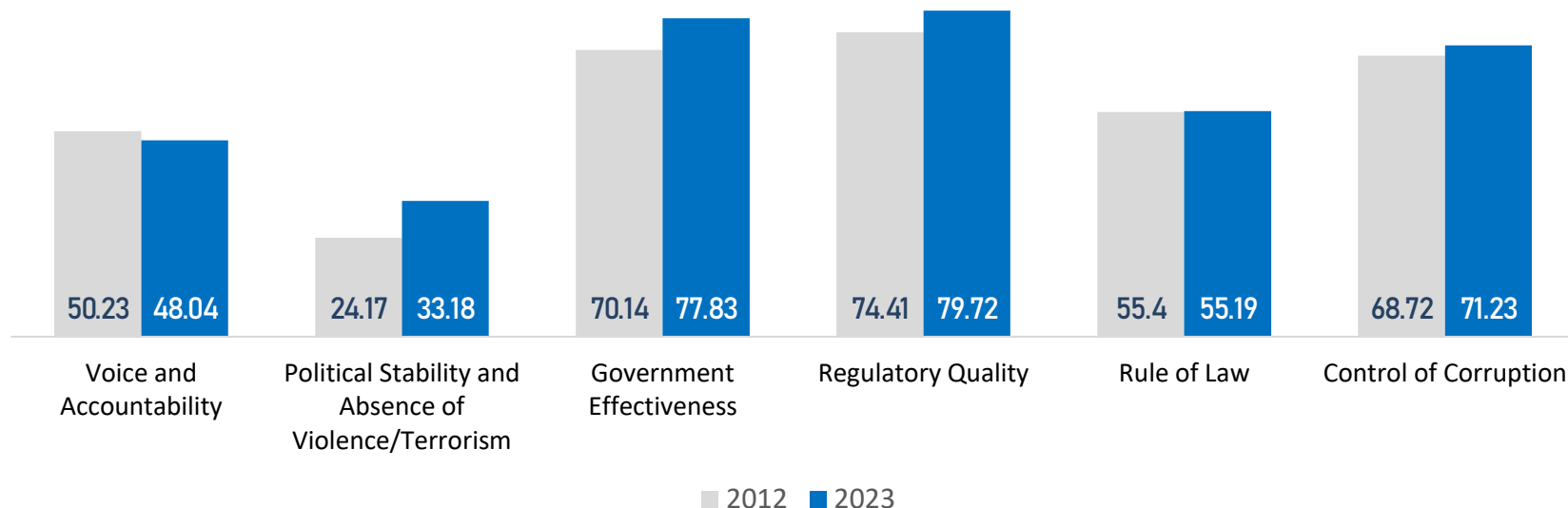

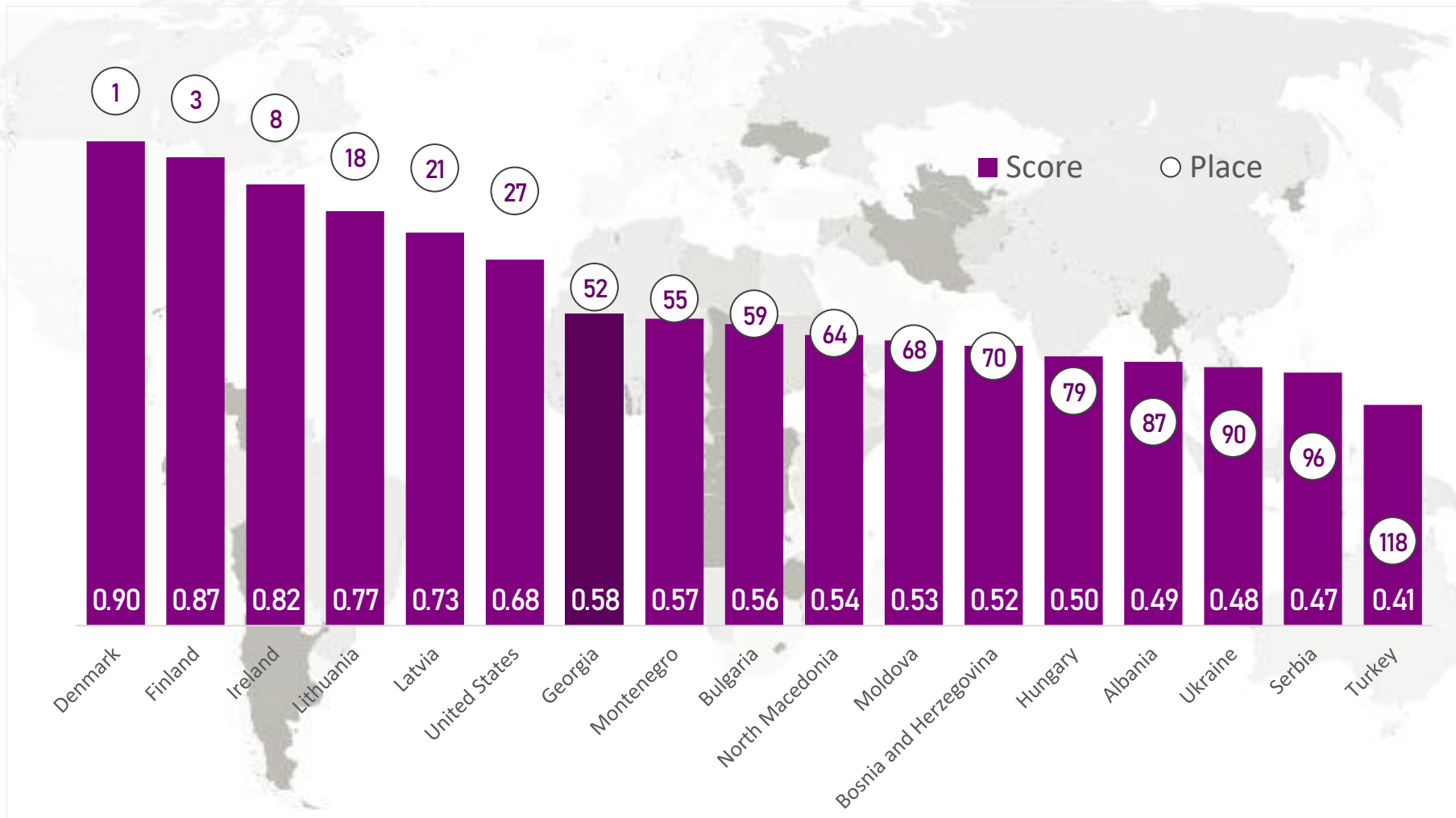


- According to the “Rule of Law Index” by the World Justice Project, in 2025 Georgia ranks **52nd position** amongst 143 countries with a **0.58 score**
- Georgia is a leader and ranks the **first position** among the 15 countries in the EECA region and **6th position** among 41 upper middle income countries. Georgia is ahead of all EU candidate countries.

Chandler Governance Index „Good Government Index“



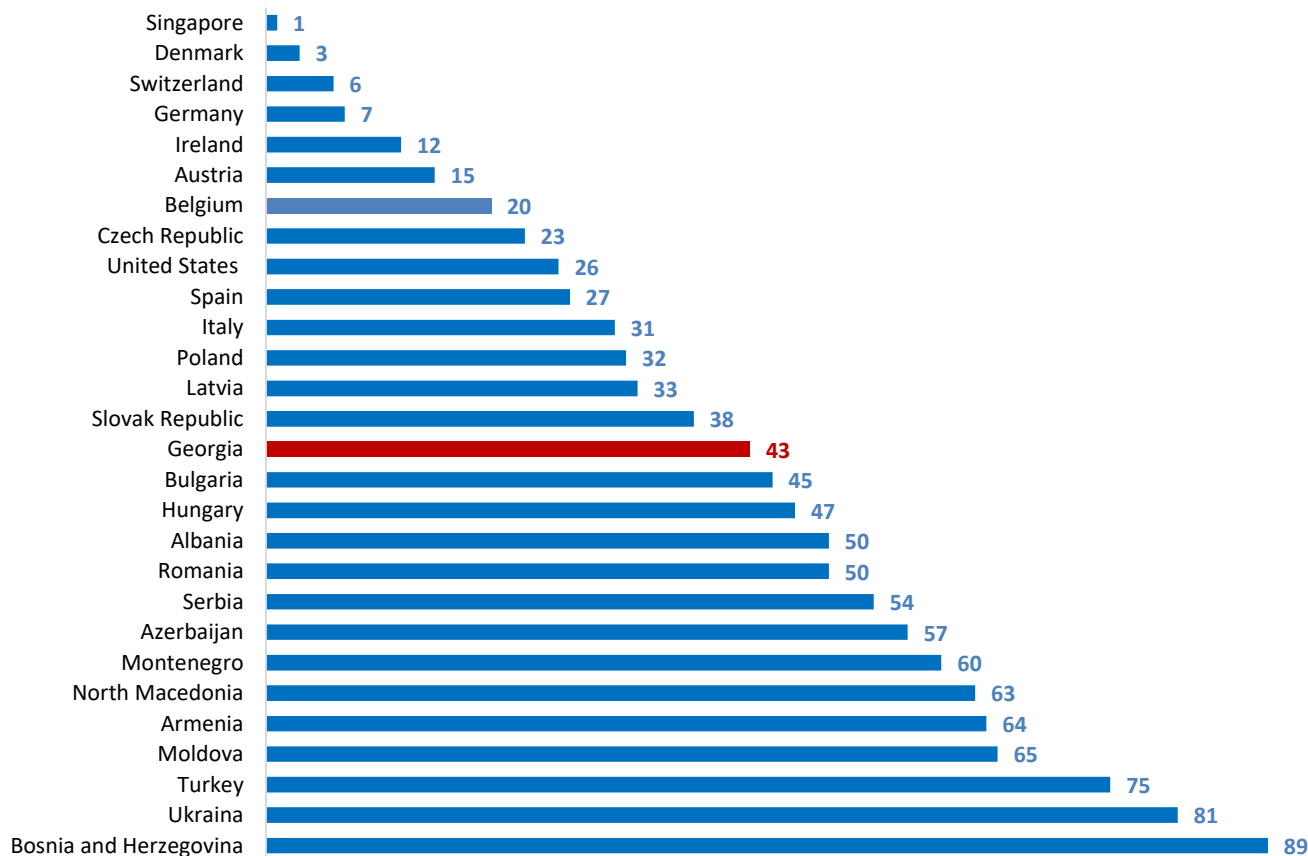
- Pursuant to the Chandler Governance Institute “Good Government Index 2026”, Georgia ranked 43th position among 133 countries worldwide. In a **regional context** (*Middle East, Central & West Asia*) **Georgia ranked 5th position** (*among 18 countries*).
- **Georgia is ahead** of following European countries: Hungary, Bulgaria, Romania and also, **all EU candidate countries** – Moldova, Ukraine, Serbia, Albania, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Turkey and Bosnia and Herzegovina.
- The Government is assessed by **35 indicators**, which is unified into **7 factors**: Leadership & Foresight (1), Robust Laws & Policies (2), Strong Institutions (3), Financial Stewardship (4), Attractive Marketplace (5), Global Influence & Reputation (6), Helping People Rise (7).
- Georgia ranked **12th position in terms of Attracting Investments**, 14th - in terms of Transparency, 20th - in terms of Stable Business Regulations, 25th – in terms of Quality of Bureaucracy, etc.
- The report underscores that **Georgia’s progress in the rankings** is fully consistent with the reforms implemented and currently being advanced by the Government of Georgia to further improve the country’s business environment. It also provides a positive assessment of the measures undertaken within the framework of the Government of Georgia’s program to strengthen the investment climate and modernize public administration and service delivery.

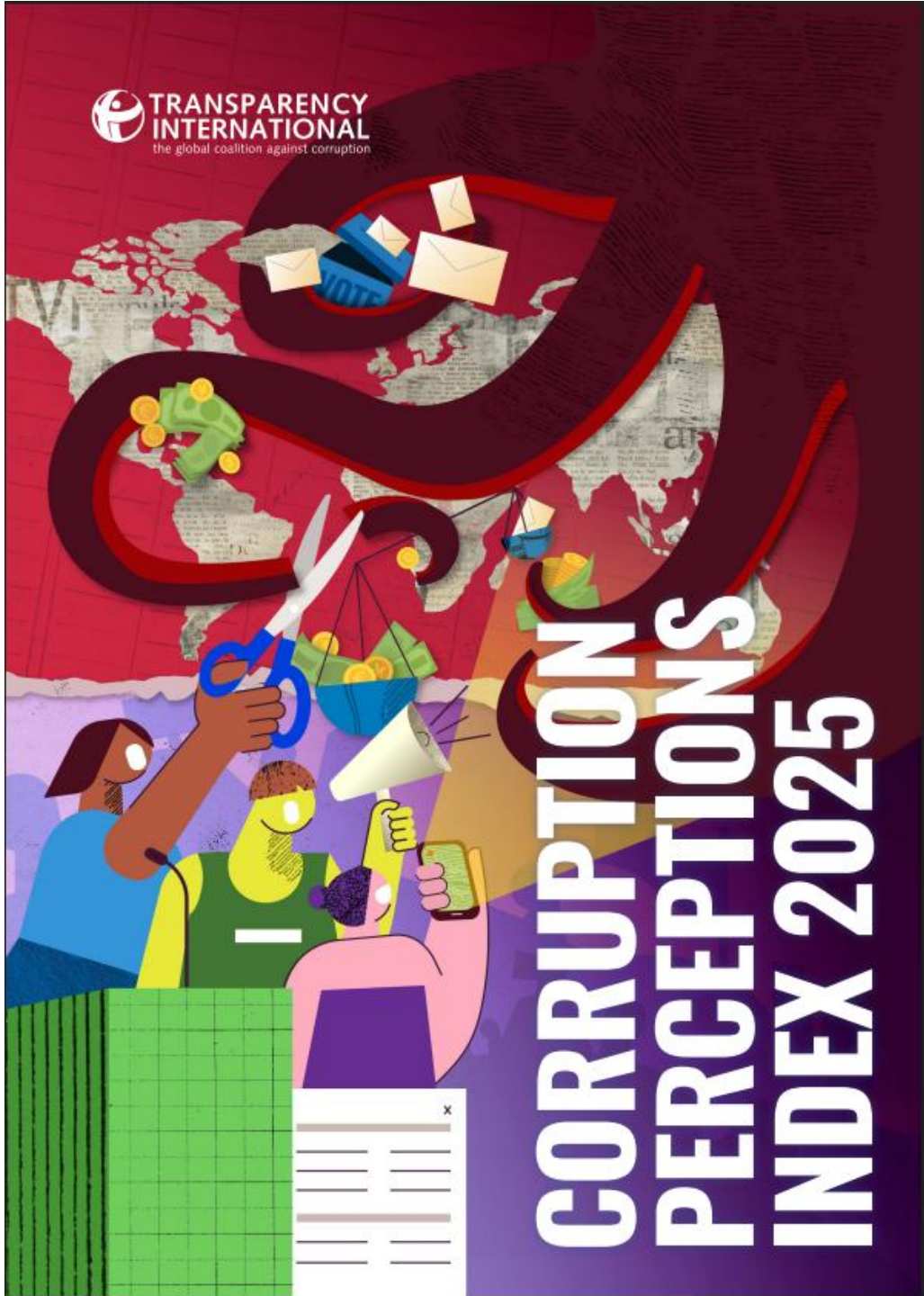
Chandler Governance Index „Good Government Index“

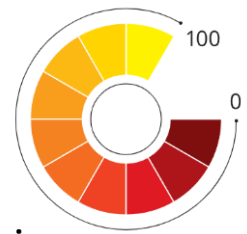

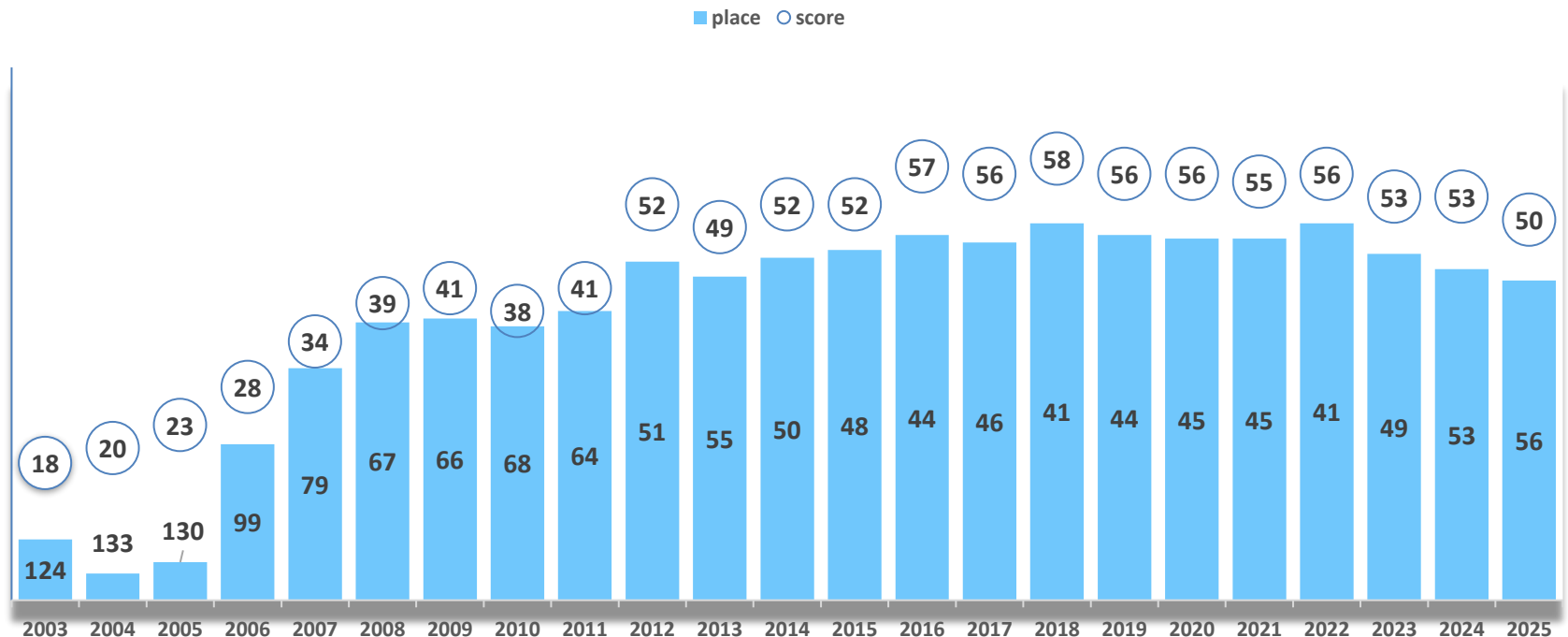

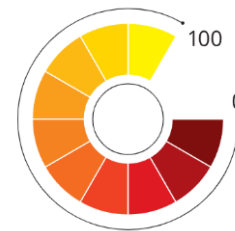
- According to the “**Corruption Perception Index**” of Transparency International in 2025, Georgia is in **56th place** amongst 182 economies with a **50 score**
- Georgia is keeping **the first position** among the 19 countries in the Eastern Europe and Central Asia (EE&CA)
- Country’s score **significantly exceeds** both regional average score – 34 point and world average score – 42 point.

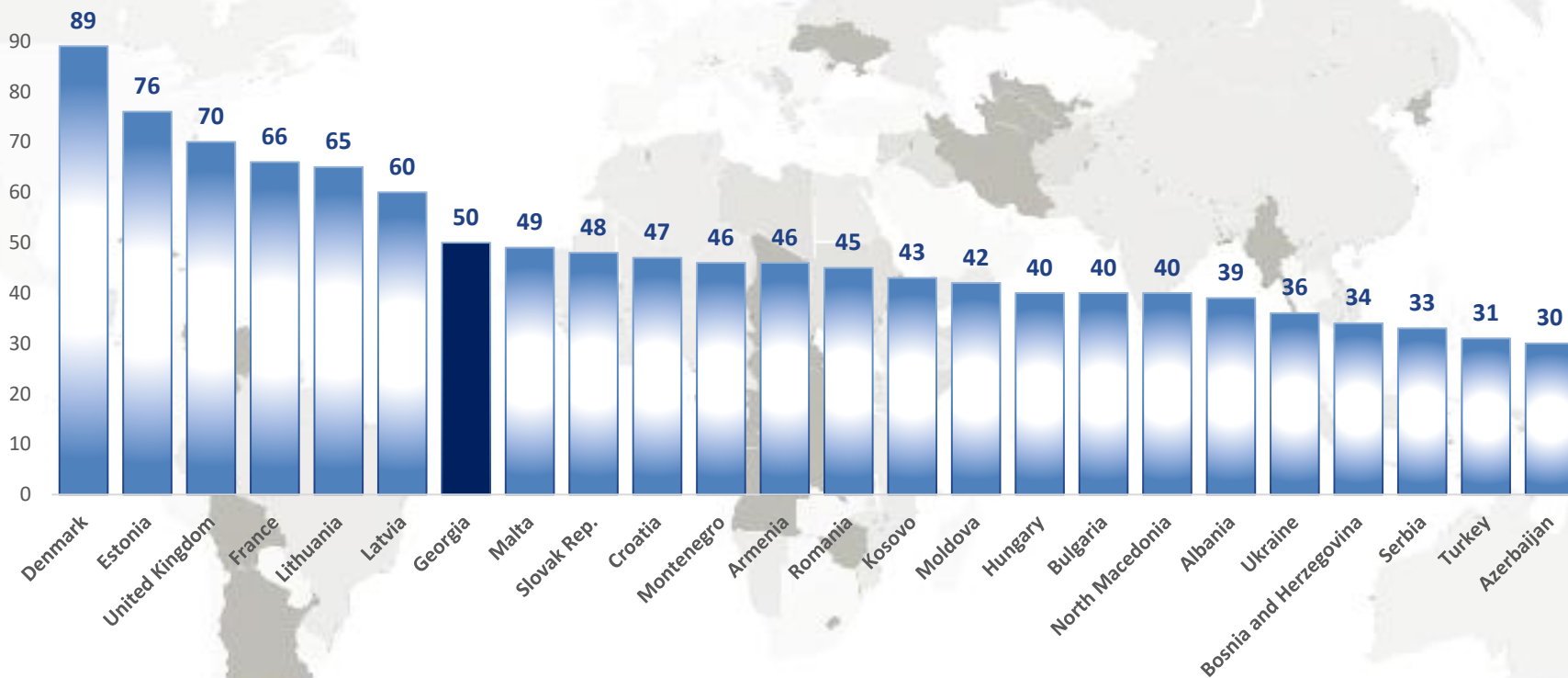


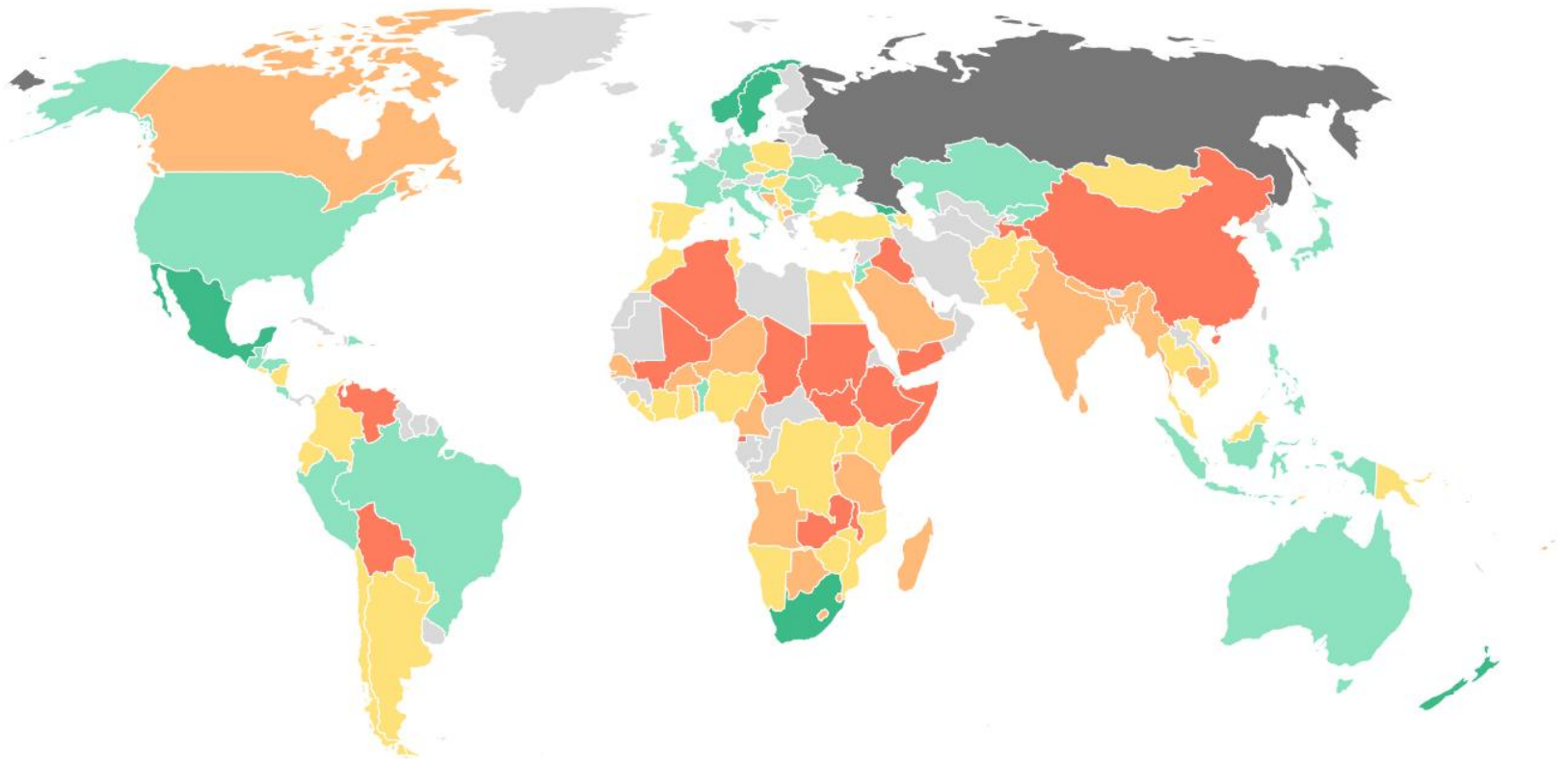

Georgia's Score Compared to Other Countries



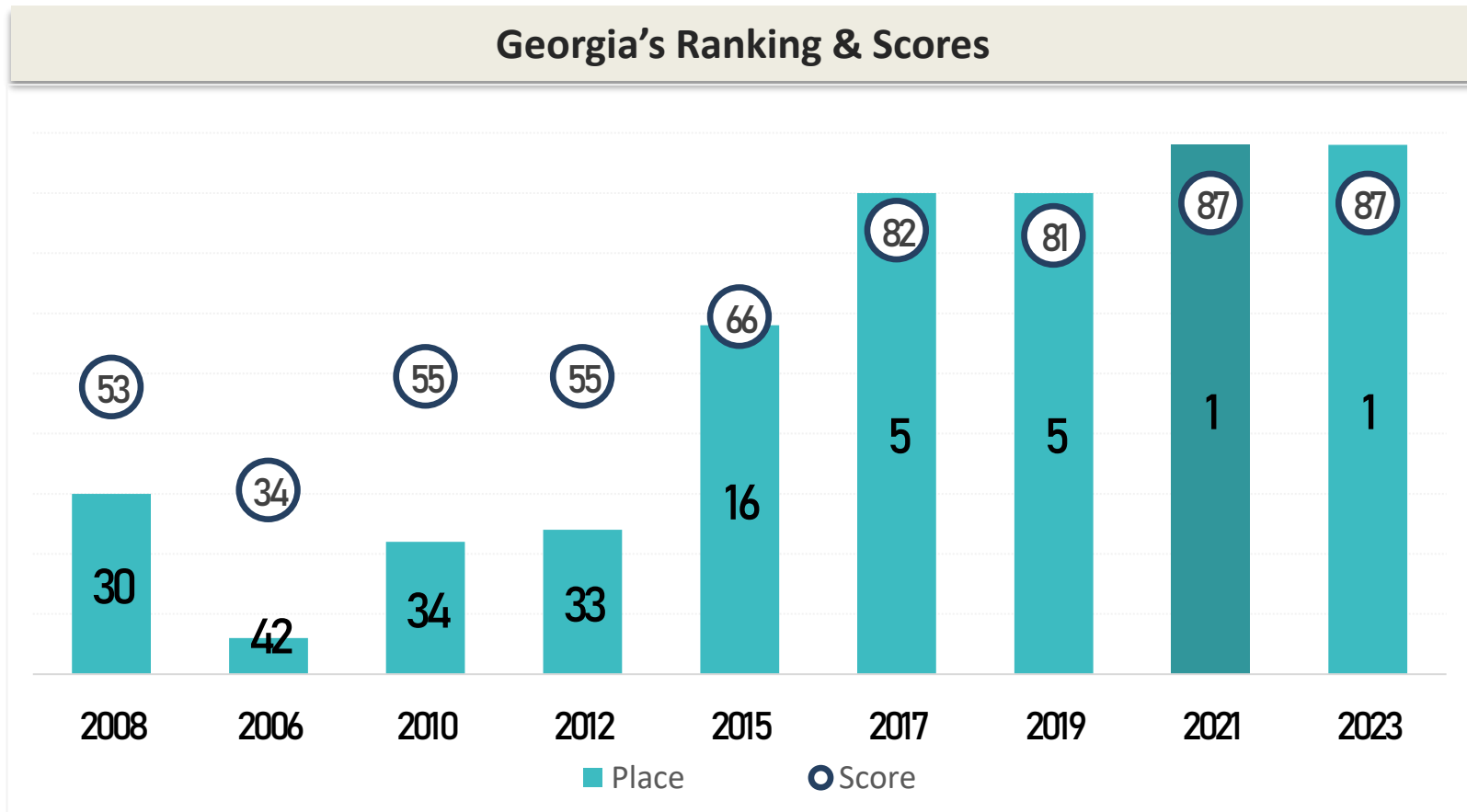

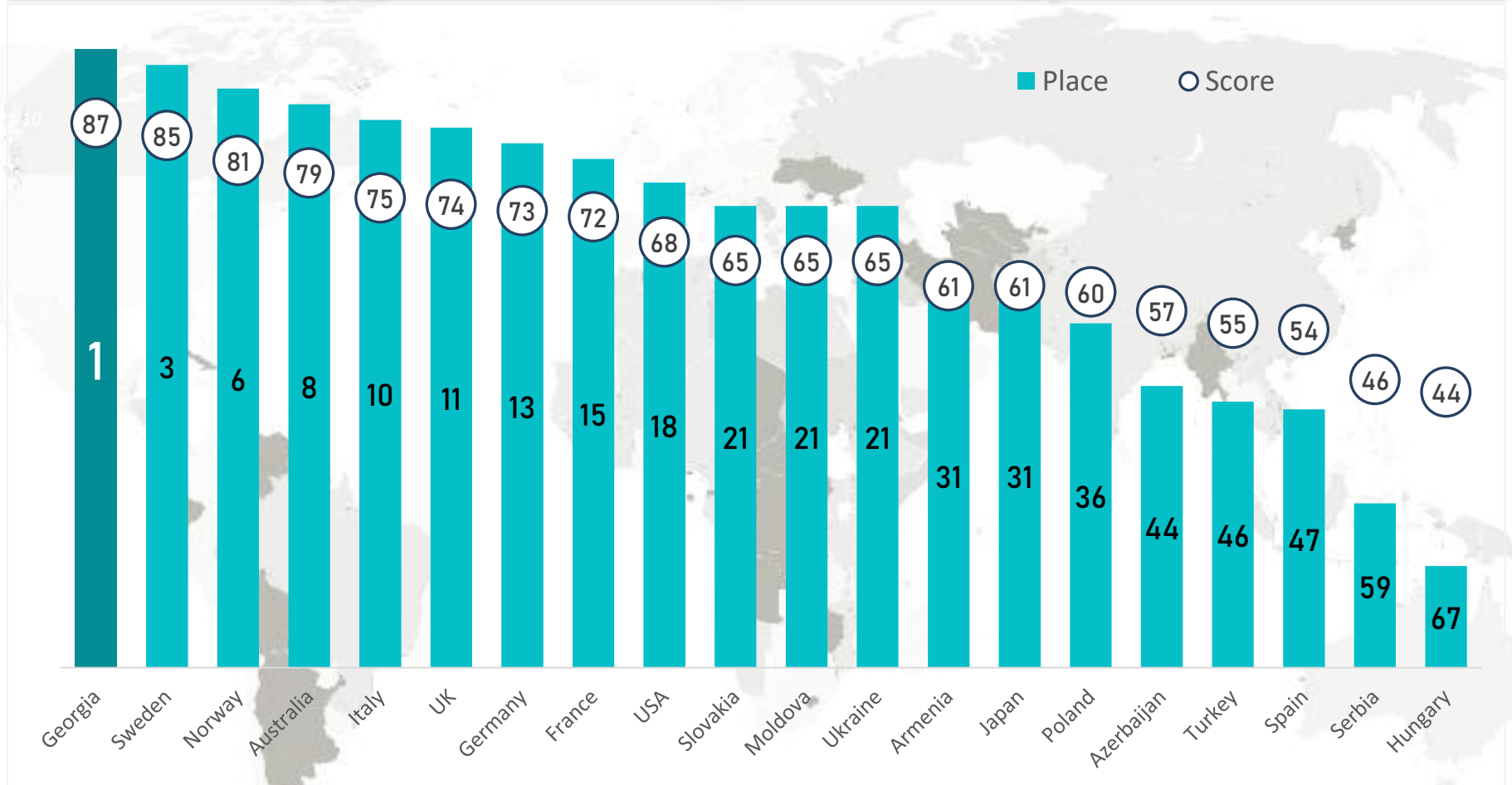

Georgia's Score Compared to Other Countries





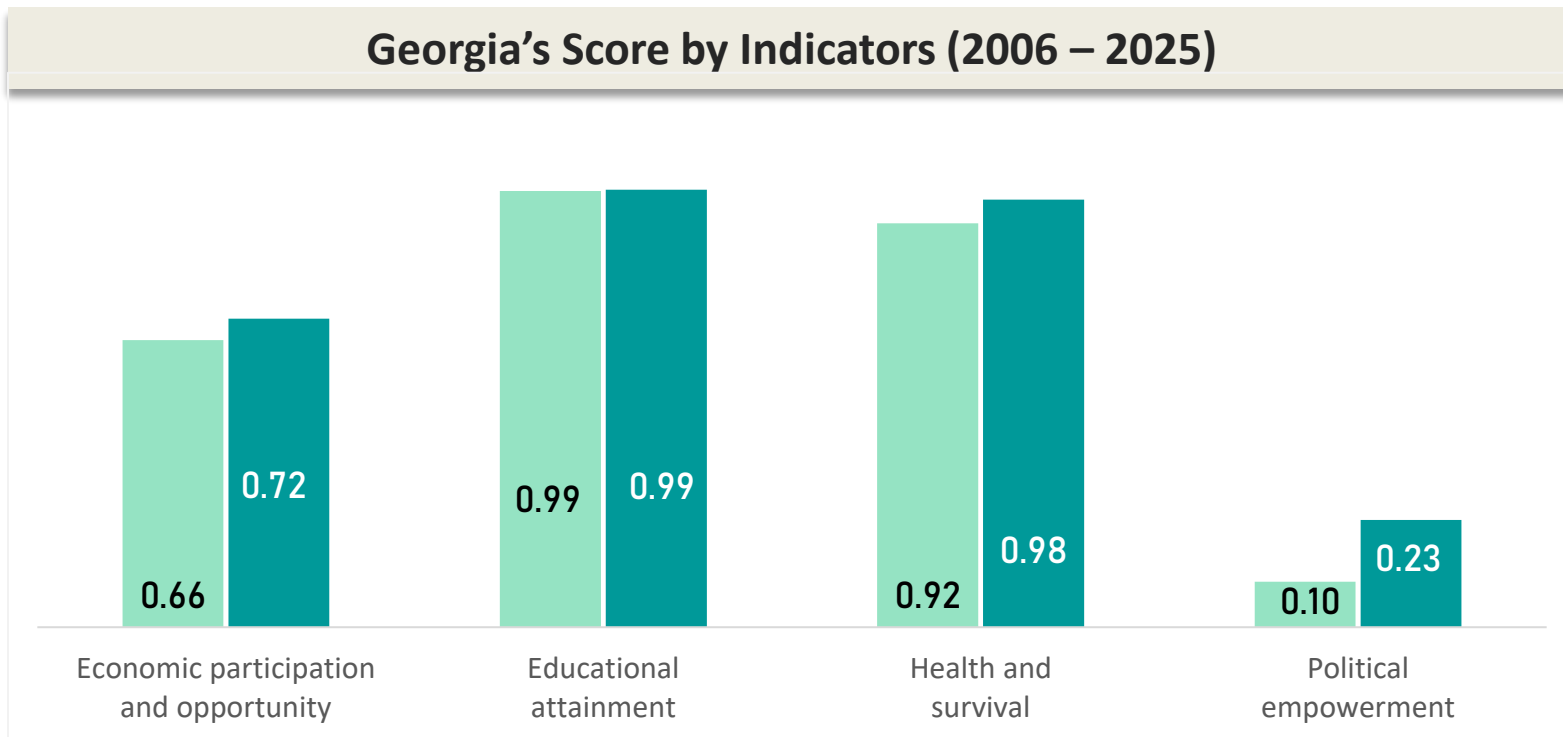

- ✓ In 2025, Georgia ranks **63rd place** with a score of 0.729 among 148 countries (2024 - **69th place** with a score of 0.716, 2023 - **76th position** with a score 0.708).

The Global Gender Gap Index (GGI) benchmarks the evolution of gender-based gaps among four key dimensions - Economic Participation and Opportunity, Educational Attainment, Health and Survival, and Political Empowerment
